**Teacher Excellence Award**

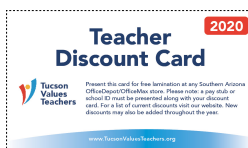


Congratulations to our February Teacher Excellence Award winner, Gabrielle Halko!

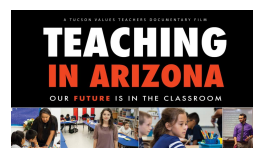
